It is shifted in separate library building in the year 1997.TheFoundation Stone of separate library building was laid on 8<sup>th</sup> March 1997 with the auspicious hands of Hon.Minister Dattaji Rane,Dept.of Higher and Technical Education,Govt.of Maharashtra.

Application of Information Technology: Internet Facility was started in the year 2009. Internet Lab was Inaugurated by Dr D.K.Veer, Librarian, Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2016. Four Computers have been installed for students & Research scholars to access internet & online Resources etc. SOUL 2.0 Version which is launched by INFLIBNET, Apex body of UGC, is used for the automation of the library.

### **COLLECTION**

According to Fifth Law of Library Science stated by Padmashri Dr S.R.Ranganathan "Library is Growing Organism", now the library has reached upto the collection of 9157 books and 3725 bound volumes of periodicals. During the year 2015-2016 181 books are added in the library. Library has 67 International and 47 National journals and thirteen state and national level news papers in Marathi and English. Library has subscribed four International and eighteen National Journals. Library has also subscribed millions of e-resources through N-LIST and Remote Access Facility of Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Library.

### **LIBRARY RULES**

- 1. Every student shall be provided with two books for home reading.
- 2. The book shall be issued for the time of period of seven days.
- 3. Reference books viz. encyclopaedias, dictionaries, year books, loose issues of periodicals-journals will not be issued. They are for referencing in library only.
- 4. A request along with title and author of book will be deposited to get book reserve facility.
- 5. If any student is found tearing, stealing or defacing books/journals, the cost of book will be recovered as a penalty.
- 6. Theses and Dissertations in all subjects will be in the sole charge of librarian.

These shall be available for reading to the members in library premises only.

- 7. Members will get books for reading after producing his/her Identity Card.
- 8. Books, periodicals and any other material that have been taken out of the library are liable to be recalled at any time and when so recalled they must be returned at once.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. The library will ordinarily remain open on week days from 9.30 a.m. to 5.45 p.m.
- 2. Every user of the library has to sign in the Visitors Register while entering in the library.
- 3. Student shall keep silence within the library.
- 4. While entering in the library, mobile phones are to be kept on silent mode.
- 5. Food and drinks are not permitted in the library.
- 6. During class room hours students are not allowed in the library.
- 7. Students are liable for punishment, if they are found damaging the library property.
