## IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION

Candidates desiring to seek admission to the Institute, should visit the Institute on their own to check provisional merit list, which will be displayed after TWO days of the closing date of registration. Candidates are advised to read the rules and regulations carefully and note the admission schedule displayed on the notice board. No correspondence will be made in this respect.

## Introduction

The Institute of Science was established in 1974, for the development of Marathwada Region. The Institute started with a single discipline, the department of Botany but soon established the unique departments of Microbiology, Biophysics, Geology, and Biotechnology. While establishing every department / subject, it was decided not to have duplication of any subject already existing in Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University so as to provide wide scope of choice to the students of this region in opting latest emerging subject.

The Institute spreads over an area of 25 acres in picturesque vicinity of Aurangabad Caves near Nipat Niranjan Temple.

The Institute is the only Post-graduate and Research Institute in Marathwada Region. It has unique features in possessing highly qualified faculty, laboratories with sophisticated instruments and research facilities, a rich library and internet facility. The Institute has following departments.

The academic year will commence as per Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University directives.

### III) General Instructions to candidate seeking admission to M.Sc. Courses & Ph.D. :

1. All admissions will be finalized by the Institute.
2. If a candidate desires to apply in more than one subject he / she should submit a separate application form for each subject.
3. The allotment of seats for admission to post graduate courses in Sciences will be as per circular No. Acad NP/M.Sc./71/2004 of Dr. B.A.M.U. Aurangabad.

## DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR MARATHWADA UNIVERSITY

### CIRCULAR NO. Acad NP/M.Sc./71/2004

It is hereby informed to all the concerned that on the recommendations of the Academic Council, the Management Council at its meeting held on 04-03-2004 has accepted the amended Regulation - 1381 pertaining to allotment of seats for admission to Post-Graduate courses under the Faculty of Science.

The amended R-1381 shown as under :

**REGULATION-1381** : Allotment of seats for admission to Post-Graduate Courses under the Faculty of Science :

- a) A student of 10th & 12th Standard from Maharashtra & B.Sc. from this University, Completed Three Years..... 80%
- b) A student of 11th & 12th Standard from any Other States & B.Sc. from this University Completed Three Years... 10%
- c) A student of B.Sc. from other states including N.R.I..... 10%

This is effective from the Academic Year 2004-2005.

4. The Candidates are advised to read the prospectus carefully and apply for the Courses only if they satisfy the eligibility conditions. A candidate applying for admission to the Institute

should read the Registration form for admission carefully and write requisite information in his / her own handwriting correctly. Incomplete application forms will be rejected. If it is found, that the information supplied in the application is incorrect, such registration will be cancelled.

5. Candidate belonging to University other than Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University is required to obtain a certificate of Eligibility from the Registrar of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University before the FIRST TERM ends, failing which he / she will be liable to be declared ineligible for the course. If for some reasons the University declares him / her ineligible for admission, the Institute will cancel such admission and the concerned student will have to leave the course.
6. A candidate should bear in mind that he / she can pursue only one course at a time in the University. He / she will have to give a declaration to that effect at the time of applying for admission to a course. Candidates in service will not be considered for admission.
7. The applicant has to give his / her permanent home address in the application form which will be registered in the Institute record. Any change therein will be effected only on an application made by the concerned student duly attested by his / her guardian giving reasons for such a change.
8. A tentative merit list will be displayed on Notice Board after TWO days of the closing date of registration. Next day a Final Merit List alongwith provisional admission list will be displayed.
9. Admission for Ph.D. are given with availability of seats with concerned guides.
10. The rules given in the prospectus are subject to change as per the directives issued by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University and Govt. of Maharashtra from time to time. Any such change(s) will be displayed on the notice board.
11. Re-admission to the same class will not be given.

IV) Admission Rules :

1. Registration form together with the prospectus can be obtained from the Institute Office on payment of Rs.20/- in person at the counter or by a crossed postal order / D.D. drawn in favour of the Director, Institute of Science, Aurangabad. If the application is required by post, the postal order / D.D. should accompany a self address envelope of 8 inches x 10 inches with postal stamps of Rs. 10.00.
2. Registration Form filled in candidate's own handwriting alongwith registration fees of Rs. 25/- in cash or Indian Postal Order or D.D. in the name of Director, Institute of Science, Aurangabad should reach the office of the Director, Institute of Science, Nipat Niranjan Nagar, Caves Road, Aurangabad - 431 004, within ten days from the date of declaration of results of the qualifying Examination of the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University or last date as prescribed by the University.
3. Institute will not be responsible for any postal or any kind of delay. **Incomplete application will be rejected.**
4. The Registration Form must be accompanied by the following documents duly attested by a Gazetted Officer / Principal of any college and completed in all respects.
  - (a) True copies attested by a Gazetted Officer of the Marks Memo of University Examinations. B.Sc. I, II and III year (passed, failed, A.T.K.T. and failed.)
  - (b) True copies of Marks memo and certificates of S.S.C. & H.S.C. Examinations.
  - (c) True copy of the Migration Certificate (For those who have passed the qualifying Examination from University other than Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University.
  - (d) True copy of the College Leaving Certificate / T.C. **(T.C. submitted should have all its columns filled in.)**

- (e) Recent pass-port size photograph of the candidate be affixed to the Registration form.
- (f) True copy of the Caste Certificate & relevant document from competent authority, if admission is sought under reserved category and at the time of admission original caste verification certificate from State Social Welfare Department be submitted. Recent true copy of Creamy layer certificate for NT 2, NT3 and OBC Candidates.
- (g) An original Medical Certificate from Medical Practitioner not below M.B.B.S. Degree indicating candidate's fitness to undertake post-graduate studies be submitted at the time of admission.
- (h) Nationality & Domicile certificate (for candidates other than Maharashtra State)

**ALL ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION WITHOUT FAIL ALONG WITH THE PRESCRIBED FEES.**

A student desiring to seek admission to the hostel has to apply in the prescribed form, which can be obtained from the accounts section of Institute. The details regarding admission fees and other charges are given in the hostel admission form along with the Rules and Regulations of the hostel.

- 6. 3% seats are reserved for physically handicapped candidates. However these seats will be filled from the respective category.
- 7. Candidates with less than 45% in all the optional subjects taken together at their qualifying examinations will not be admitted to M.Sc. Course. However, the candidates belonging to reserved categories should have a minimum of 40% marks.
- 8. Admission will be finalized by a committee consisting of the following members
  - (a) Director of the Institute. (b) Heads of the Departments.
  - (c) A staff member from backward class.
- 9. Admission made to any course of study in the Institute will be provisional, subject to confirmation of eligibility by the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathward University. The Institute will not be responsible, if the Candidate is not found eligible by the University.
- 10. In case of candidates passing the qualifying examination in more than the stipulated attempts, 2% marks will be deducted for each additional attempt, while preparing the merit list.
- 11. Admission once given in a specific subject will not be changed unless approved by the Director of the Institute.
- 12. The Director reserves the right to refuse admission to a candidate in the interest of discipline and academic standard of the Institute.

14. Foreign students seeking admission to this Institute must ensure that all their papers are clear and as per the Govt. of India rules and regulations.

2. Tuition fees for Ph.D. Course ((Details available in accounts section)

3. Free Ship - E.B.C., P.T.C., etc are also available. (Details available in accounts section)

4. Caution Money and Library Deposit are refundable when the student leaves the Institute on getting NOC from the concerned Department. A student should apply for refund of the same within one complete year, after he/she actually leaves the Institute either by obtaining the leaving certificate or by informing in writing of his/her intention to leave the Institute.

OR

Within one complete financial year after the date of successful completion of the course, whichever is earlier.

5. (a) Caution money and Library deposit if not claimed by the student within the prescribed time limit will be forfeited.
- (b) A student discontinuing studies for the M.Sc. or Ph.D. course is required to give satisfactory reasons for doing so, other wise the tuition fees and Library deposit are liable to be forfeited.
- (c) The whole amount of tuition fees will be refunded to the student, if his/her provisional admission is cancelled by the University. This is also applicable for the Self-supporting Courses of Information Technology and Computer Science.
- (i) 90% of the consolidated fees actually paid may be refunded to the student who leaves the Institute to join a professional degree course. If at the time of applying for admission he/she intimates that he/she has also applied for admission to one or more of the professional courses and make a written application for the refund of fees on submission of a letter of admission from the Principal of Professional College / Institute to the Director, Institute of Science **within 15 days** from the date of his / her admission to the professional course. In any case before 31st July of the same year.
- (ii) 50% of the consolidated fees actually paid by the student may be refunded if he/she fulfills the condition in Rule (i) above and applies for refund of fees after 31st July but on or before 31st August of the same year. The application for refund of fees, in such cases must be accompanied by a certificate from the Principal of the Professional College actually joined by the student stating the date of his/her application of admission to the Professional Course. Original receipts should be enclosed to the application for refund of fees.
- (iii) If the candidate fails to inform about his/her admission in other Professional courses in his/her admission form, the claim for refund of fees will not be entertained.
- (iv) After 31st August the claim for refund of fees will not be entertained under any circumstances.

**VIII) Scholarships and concessions :**

Various types of scholarships like Government of India Scholarship, National Loan Scholarship, Open Merit Scholarship, Junior/Senior Research Fellowships under U.G.C./C.S.I.R., Government of Maharashtra Research Fellowship and Eklavya Scholarship are available in the Institute and particulars regarding the same can be obtained from the Institute Office.

**IX) Library :**

The Institute has adequate library facility. Books issued to them must be kept in good condition and returned to the Librarian within the stipulated time. Students should observe library rules framed from time to time.

**X) Medical Examination :**

Every student on the roll of the Institute has to present himself/herself for Medical Examination before a Medical panel appointed by the Institute.

**XI) Identity Card :**

(i) Every student admitted to the Institute must possess an Identity Card. (ii) He/She should affix his/her recent passport size photograph on the card and fill the relevant entries in the card. The Identity Card will be attested by the Director of the Institute. (iii) Identity card is helpful in getting books from the Library and for receiving payment from the Institute Office. It is therefore necessary for every student to have his/her card with him/her when he/she attends

the Institute. (iv) A duplicate Identity Card will be issued on payment of Rs.50/-.

**XII) Concessions :**

Railway / Bus concession will be issued during winter and summer vacations.

**XIII) Sports Facility :**

Different in-door and out-door Sports facilities are available in the Institute. Students are encouraged to avail the same.

**XIV) Hostel Facilities :**

Well furnished separate Boys and Girls hostels with independent rooms with all required amenities are available in the premises of the Institute.

**XVI) General Instructions and discipline :**

Every Student shall adhere strictly to the undertaking given in application form and to the conduct of rules.

- (i) Students should produce their Identity Card on demand when they are in the premises of the Institute.
- (ii) Students are expected to maintain discipline and behave in polite manner while they are in the Institute premises. They should not act in any way which would undermine the expected high traditions of the Institute.
- (iii) Students must not remain absent from the Institute classes or examinations without the prior permission from the concerned Head of the Department.
- (iv) Students must attend more than 75% of theory & practical classes and they must show satisfactory performance in the first and second terminal examinations. Failing which the student will not be allowed to appear for the University Final Examination. (GR.NO. TEH 3396/3428 Vm.{e. \_\$lmb` {dñVma ^dZ, \_w\$~B© 400 032, 17-4-96) E.B.C. and G.O.I. Scholarship holder must have 75% attendance and satisfactory performance in all the examinations of

the Institute (vide G.R.No. E.B.C.-1037/39442/949/MBK-2 dated 7-9-1988).

- (v) Extra Curricular activities and functions of the students forum will be performed in the Institute in consultation with and after obtaining prior permission from the Director, Institute has established Alumni Association. All the students completing the M.Sc. courses from Institute are encouraged to become members.
- (vi) Guests shall be invited to deliver lectures in the Institute after seeking the permission from Director.
- (vii) Students must do nothing either inside or outside the Institute that will interfere with the orderly governance and discipline of the Institute.
- (viii) Students are strictly prohibited from smoking and chewing tobacco in the Institute premises. They are advised not to spoil the walls and corridors. They are expected to help to maintain Institute premises neat and clean.
- (ix) Students should be vigilant and take care to see that the books, equipments and any Institute material they use are not damaged and see that the Institute does not suffer any loss because of their negligence.
- (x) Research students submitting synopsis and / or thesis for Doctorate degree of the University are required to submit the same through the Director of the Institute after obtaining. No Dues Certificate from the concerned Department and all other departments, library and Office. The Ph.D. students will hand over a copy of his/her thesis/dissertation/Research paper to the Office of the Institute before submission to the University.
- (xi) Research students will return all the apparatus issued to him / her to the Laboratory Assistant / Stores Officer. He / She shall return the Library books issued to him/her in time.
- (xii) The decision of the Director shall be final in matter pertaining to discipline and penalties imposed on those violating the rules and undermining discipline of the Institute.
- (xiii) To qualify for appearing the University Examination a student.
  - Must attend not less than 75% of the lectures and practicals.
  - Must satisfy the Institute authorities with regard to his / her proficiency and academic fitness in the subject by showing good performance in the Institute examinations and seminars conducted during the academic year.
  - No student should remain absent from the Institute without the prior permission of the Director. In case of absence due to illness, a medical certificate from the Registered Medical Practitioners should be submitted and such absence should be reported to the Director immediately. Medical Certificates should be submitted within 10 days from the first day of the absence on account of illness. In such cases a 10% relaxation in the attendance will be considered.
  - The Director reserves the right of allowing / disallowing any student from appearing for the University examination on recommendation of the committee. However, the decision of the Director will be final.
- (xiv) Legal matters Subject to Aurangabad Jurisdiction.
- (xv) Any item not covered by the above rules lies under the discretionary powers of the Director.
